**Subject: Urgent Request for Your Intervention Regarding the Non-Implementation of a Judicial Ruling Ordering the Release of Journalist Naseh Shaker**

We, the undersigned, the Committee to Protect Journalists (CPJ), an international organization dedicated to defending journalists' rights and headquartered in New York, United States, and the Yemeni Media Freedoms Observatory (Marsadak), write to inform you of the continued detention of journalist Naseh Ahmed Mohammed Shaker, despite the issuance of a final and enforceable court ruling ordering his immediate release.

According to the attached official documents, the Specialized Criminal Court in Aden Governorate issued a clear judicial ruling on January 20, 2026, ordering the release of journalist Naseh Shaker and deeming the more than 25 months he has already spent sufficient in detention. The Public Prosecution did not file any appeal against the initial ruling within the legally prescribed period, rendering the judgment final and binding, and requiring its immediate enforcement in accordance with the law.

Despite this, information indicates that the security authorities and the administration of Bir Ahmed Prison in Aden continue to refrain from implementing the ruling to date. This constitutes a serious undermining of the rule of law and an infringement upon judicial independence, leaving the journalist subject to arbitrary detention without legal basis.

In light of the oversight and human rights mandate entrusted to the Ministry of Human Rights to monitor detainees' conditions and ensure respect for legal safeguards, we urge your Ministry to take immediate action, including:

- Officially addressing the relevant Security Authorities and the Bir Ahmed Prison Administration to demand the immediate enforcement of the judicial ruling and ensure the unconditional release of journalist Naseh Shaker.

- Communicating with the Office of the Public Prosecutor and the competent judicial authorities to reaffirm the binding nature of court rulings and the impermissibility of obstructing their implementation.
- Forming a ministerial follow-up committee to visit the prison and investigate the reasons behind the refusal to enforce the ruling.
- Issuing a clear public statement expressing the Ministry's rejection of any arbitrary detention or obstruction of judicial decisions and reaffirming respect for constitutional and legal guarantees.
- Including this case in the Ministry's periodic reports and submitting it to relevant national and international human rights bodies.

The continued detention of a journalist despite the issuance of a final court ruling ordering his release sends a negative message regarding state institutions' respect for the rule of law. It also affects Yemen's human rights commitments and deepens the climate of concern among journalists and media professionals.

We hope for your urgent intervention and the exercise of your oversight and human rights responsibilities to ensure the enforcement of the ruling and justice for the concerned journalist, in a manner that strengthens confidence in judicial institutions and safeguards the fundamental rights guaranteed by law.
